

Terms of Use

HIS-UK is a site operated by the University of Southampton (the “University” or “we”, or “us”), a not-for-profit research institution, with the aim of developing online behavioural packages for condom promotion.

By using www.his-uk.net/ (the “Site”), you confirm that you accept the following terms of use (“Terms of Use”) and that you agree to comply with them. By creating an account you indicate that you have read and accepted our Terms of Use:

1. Account terms:

- You must be 16 or over to use this Site. When you register, you need to provide a valid email address and/or mobile number, your age, sexual orientation, postcode and ethnicity. By registering on this Site, you confirm that the information you provide is true and accurate.
- You are responsible for the information that you enter, the activity of your account, and for maintaining the security of your account and password. If you know or suspect that anyone else knows your password, you must change it straight away.
- You agree to register only once on this Site and take reasonable time and care when completing survey questionnaires. If we suspect that either is not the case, we reserve the right to withdraw access to this Site to prevent further participation and to withhold any voucher payments due to products ordered.

2. Licence to use the Site:

- If you comply with these Terms of Use, you can use the site for your own personal and non-commercial use.
- We are the legal owner of all intellectual property rights on the Site, and content unless stated otherwise. These works are protected by copyright laws and we reserve all such rights.
- The Site must not be used in any way that causes, or may cause, damage to the Site or impairment of the availability or accessibility of it; or in any way which is unlawful, illegal, fraudulent or harmful.
- The content of the Site is provided for general information only and is not intended to be, or to be interpreted, as medical opinion. The Site does not contain medical advice and we recommend that you contact your GP to treat any medical or health condition.

- HIS-UK is a condom promotion intervention developed by us. By using the Site, you are giving consent to have your data collected by us for impact and evaluation purposes of HIS-UK.
- Your data will be accessed only by our team. Anonymised data will be used to report use of the Site and it will not be possible to identify you from this data as having taken part in the programme. Any data collected or generated on the Site will be treated according to the UK Data Protection Act 2018 and the GDPR.

4. Limited warranties:

- Although we have taken reasonable efforts to update the information on our Site, we make no representation, warranties or guarantees, whether express or implied, that the content of our Site is accurate, complete or up to date. We provide the Site on an “as-is” basis only.
- The Site is made available free of charge to you. We do not guarantee that the Site, or any content on it, will always be available or be uninterrupted. We may suspend, withdraw or restrict the availability of all or any part of the Site.

5. Limitation and exclusion of liability:

- We do not exclude or limit in any way our liability to you where it would be unlawful to do so.
