Personal Data Collected Online Using Qualtrics Software

References to “data” in this Privacy notice will refer to whatever data is collected for use by the HIS-UK study using Qualtrics services. This privacy notice is to read with study documentation provided to participants, including the Participant Information Sheet.

What data do we collect?

We may collect, store and process:

- The data that you enter on the website.
- Data about your computer, for example, your IP address - a number label given to every device that connects to a computer network.
- Data about how you use the website, including the pages you have seen.
- Personal data including name, email, mobile number, and postal address (for the purposes of site allocation and for the distribution of study supplies).

Using your data

- Data will only be seen by the team involved in the HIS-UK study and IT staff working on the project. Data will be kept private and will only be used for research and audit purposes.

Cookies

The website, along with most other major websites, uses cookies. When you enter details into our website, a cookie is sent to your computer. A cookie is a small file that is saved on your computer which allows us to remember some information about you. We use cookies to identify your current session. The cookies do not contain any data that you enter into the website or data that would identify who you are. To use the website you will need to accept the cookies on your internet browser. If you decide to block the cookies, the website will not work correctly and you will not be able to use the website.
